Friday, March 8, 2024

Finish work. Be sure everything has been packed, and rush off to bed. The plan is to wake up very early and do the 13-hour drive to get to the main campsite that we will be staying at.

Saturday, March 9, 2024

Wake: 12:00 AM (midnight) Leave: 12:30

Erie/Buffalo Border Crossing - the border at this time is usually lightly occupied. Hopefully there will be minimal delay in crossing.

The Big Coffee Pot - A photo op of a large coffee pot. Maybe a sign that coffee is needed at this point. A very long drive to get here. Almost the halfway point to today's final destination.

Welcome to Maryland Sign - our first time entering the state of Maryland. Pull to the side of the road and snap a pic of this moment.

Antietam National Battlefield - there is an audio tour of the bloodiest USA battle ever.

The Fauquier History Museum at the Old Jail - \$5 entry fee.

First Landing Campsite - Location 31 - We will be here for our longest-ever single stay at a campground. It is located beside an active military base that holds exercises of various types. There could be loud noises. The campsite is beside a major roadway so it will also be noisy.

In 1607, settlers landed here and built towns we will visit on this trip.

IT IS STILL WINTER. NIGHTS WILL HAVE A LOW OF ZERO DEGREES AND DAY HIGHS ARE 10 DEGREES. Bring heater, extra blanket, toques, mitts, long-johns, Hot Pockets and winter coats.



Sunday, March 10, 2024

Wake: 7:00 Leave: 8:00

Williamsburg Visitor Center - The bulk of the next few days will be this location and two other related sites nearby. Park at the visitor center for a free bus shuttle around Williamsburg. The buildings that are part of the historic town tour will have this flag that is the background image of this page.

Buy the <u>America's Historic Triangle Ticket</u>. It is \$120 each. It is good for:

- All of Colonial Williamsburg, including both museums
- Historic Jamestowne
- Jamestown Settlement
- American Revolution Museum
- Yorktown Battlefield

All locations open at 9:00 and close at 5:00

Consider walking into <u>William and Mary University</u> for the second oldest university in USA. At this location is the Muscarelle Museum of Art and the Crim Dell Bridge which according to legend, any couple that crosses the bridge together will be in love for life.

Distance to and from the Campsite is 85 KM (1:10).



Consider: If done Williamsburg early, consider doing the mural tour in Virginia Beach and walk along the boardwalk for statues are more art.

Monday, March 11, 2024

Wake: 7:00 Leave: 8:00

Yorktown Battlefield - A very important battlefield of the American Revolution. Opens at 9:00. Admission is included with the America's Historic Triangle Ticket. Sites to visit while here:

- Self-guided audio tour of the battlefield
- The visitor center
- American Revolutionary Museum
- Cemetery
- Moore House (might not be open)
- Nelson House (might not be open)

Return to Williamsburg if there is still stuff to explore Williamsburg is large enough that we might not have gotten it T: 26 D: 27 A: 1:30 Posterily, (10

Ripley's Believe It or Not! Williamsburg - There are combo packages that might make the expensive \$32 admission worth it. Closes at 7 PM for 4D movies.

Across the road is Bubba's Ice Cream Shack. Within walking distance is Christmas Mouse and Wallace's Trading Post. These stores close late.

Wake: 7:00 Leave: 8:00

Jamestown Settlement is the last of the American Historic Triangle Ticket locations. This is where settlers came in 1607 and started the USA.

Newport News Visitor Center - some displays on local history. Pick up pamphlets.

The Mariners' Museum and Park - Small \$1 admission. A replica of the USS Monitor is on site.

Return to camp - consider hiking the cypress swamp trails where snakes are plentiful.

Norfolk Botanical Garden - free with Reciprocal Membership. What potentially be in bloom:

- Camellias
- Snowballs (in the border garden)
- Daffodils (in garden wide)
- Laurustinus
- Magnolia (arboretum)
- Cherry (canal walk)
- Butterfly house might be open

Hermitage Museum and Gardens - free self guide tours
