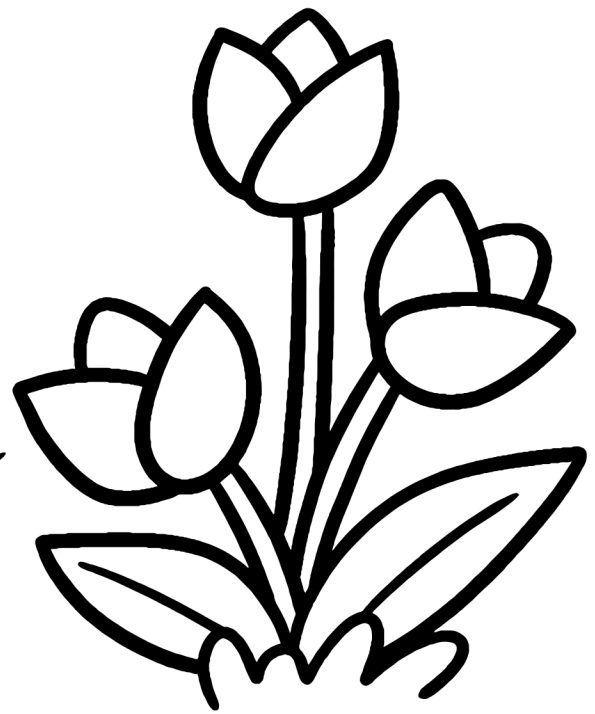


# TIP TOE THROUGH THE Tulips

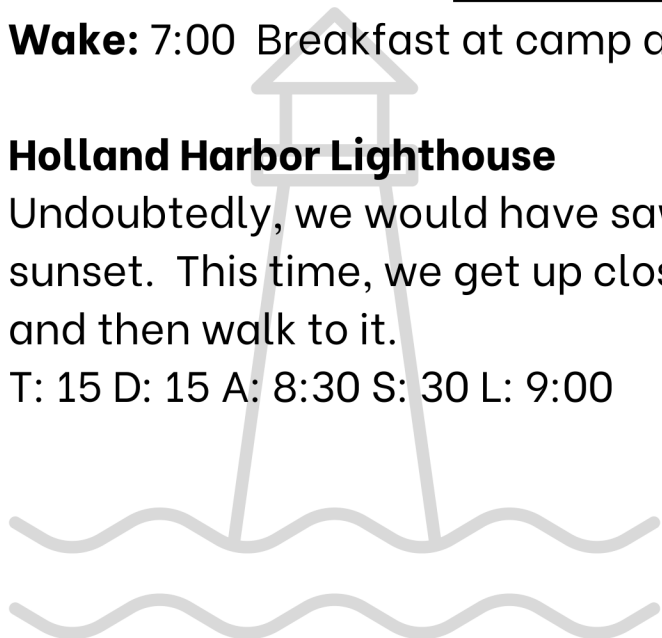
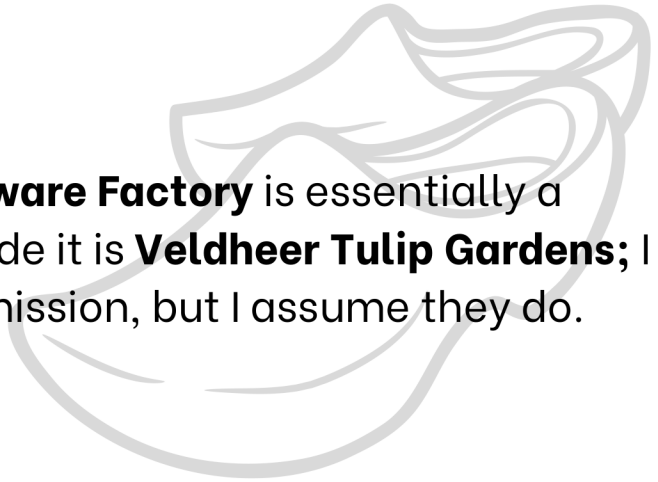
# Saturday

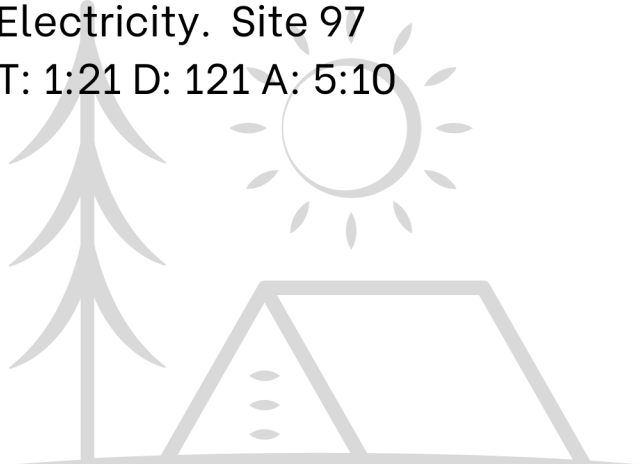

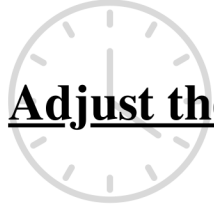

Possible to walk the 700 m from the UMMA. Free entry. Open from 1:00 to 4:00

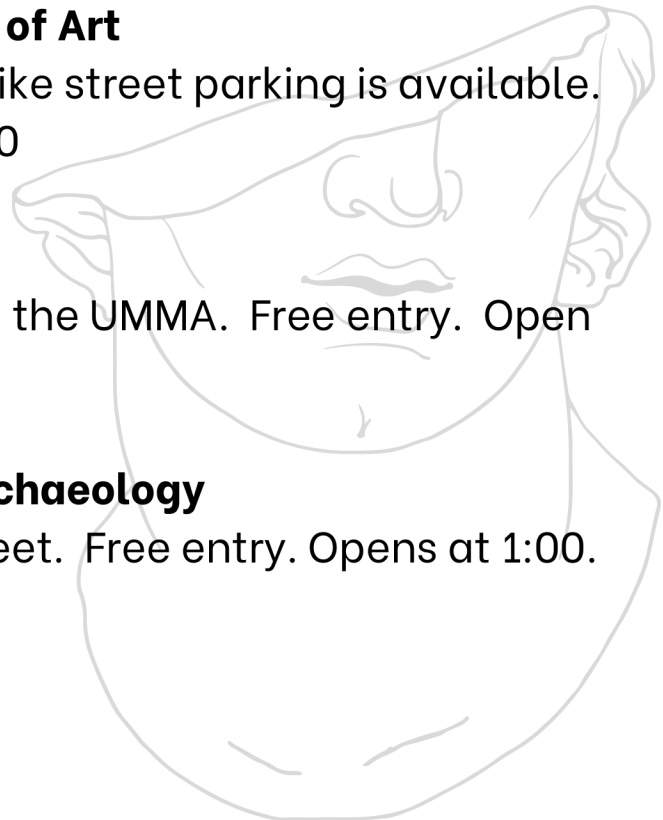
## Optional: **Kelsey Museum of Archaeology**
