Friday, June 7

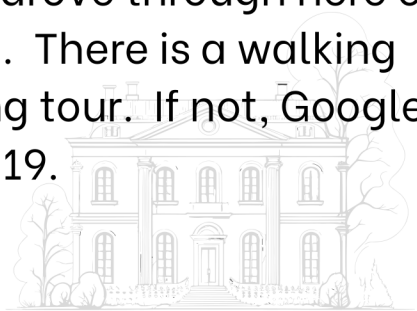
Wake: 7:00 **Breakfast** at the hotel **Leave:** 7:45

Wake: 7:30 Breakfast at the camp **Leave:** 8:30

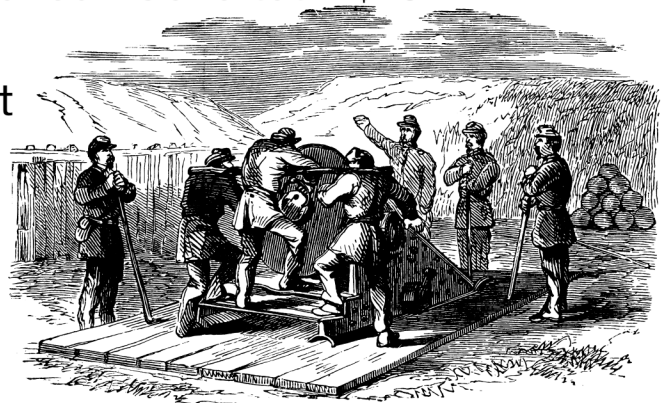

- Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art - Bedford Branch. Free admission. 12:00 to 4:30
- Fort Bedford Museum - \$7 admission. 10:00 to 4:00
- Bedford Fine Art Gallery - Likely free. 10:00 to 5:00
- Bedford County Veterans Memorial
- The Big Coffee Pot
- Ron's Antique Radio Museum - the outside looks awful but it should be free or donation for historic signage.
- Old Log Church - inside might be open, but there is also an old cemetery here.
- Bison Corral and Gift Shop - 10:00 to 5:00
- National Museum of the American Coverlet - \$10
- Gravity Hill
- And there is always Walmart

Flight 93 National Memorial - Grounds always open. The visitor centre opens at 9:00. Free entry.

Buttermilk Falls Natural Area - Free access. Able to walk behind falls. Hopefully, it is flowing.
