Tennessee State Capitol - Park at the Farmer's Market for free. Check to see if there are time limits on parking. Tours (45 minutes) are on the hour starting at 9:00.

Tennessee State Museum - After the Capitol, walk to the museum. It is free entry.

St Mary of the Seven Sorrows - Walk to this church (hopefully open) and to **The Downtown Presbyterian Church**. Multiple murals and art in the area. Make sure to visit **Walk of Fame Park**. **Church of the Holy Trinity** with many murals in the area. There are a lot of museums in the area that are all country music-related.
