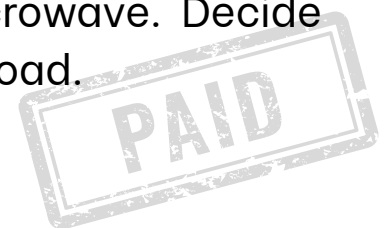
Wake: 6:30 **Breakfast:** eat in the car or McDonald's **Leave:** 8:00

Tour begins at Salem Halloween Museum. Be at least 15 minutes early. **BEING HALLOWEEN, TRAFFIC MIGHT BE CRAZY AND PARKING LIMITED.** If we arrive very early, consider checking out the Halloween Museum while we wait. The parking lot is a 20-minute walk from the tour start.

Peabody Essex Museum - Free with NARM. Opens at 10:00. Do the **Brick By Brick Tour** at 11:00 (meet at the anchor out front) and return to the museum to finish. Be sure to get tickets to **Yin Yu Tang Chinese House** (included with admission).

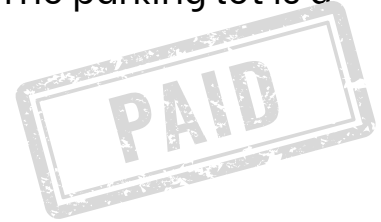

On Essex Street, starting at Peabody, is the **Lady of Salem Maritime Art** displayed. Walk to these. About two blocks from the last Lady is the **Ropes Mansion and Garden**. The building is closed, but the garden is free to explore. See if there is anything of interest. After, walk to **Punto Urban Art Museum**, where there are three blocks of murals.

Salem Witch Village - Walk to this location. Consider getting the three-attraction pass, which includes this, the Salem Wax Museum, and Frankenstein’s Castle. Being Halloween Day, the price is elevated for this occasion.

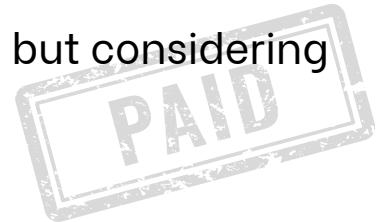
Friday, October 31

Tourist traps to consider:

- **Salem Witch Board Museum** - located inside the **Remember Salem Gift Shop**. Might be free to enter.
- **Salem Witch Trials Memorial** and **The Burying Point** - We have already visited these locations, but since we are here again, no harm in checking them out.
- **Immaculate Conception Church - Mary, Queen of the Apostles Parish** - Doubtful that it will be open, but we can try.
- **Salem Museum of Torture** - Admission
- **Proctor's Ledge Memorial** - Get a better picture of this site than we did the last time.
- **Satanic Temple** - Must drive to this location. Possible admission. Closes at 5:00.

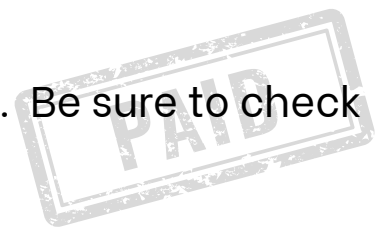

If Salem is too crowded

There is the real possibility that Salem may become extremely crowded - too crowded. After doing the Peabody tours, consider visiting Boston National Historical Park.

- USS Constitution - the oldest commissioned warship afloat. Free to tour. Open 10:00 to 6:00. Have our passports with us to board.
- Bunker Hill Monument - free to enter, but only 25 can do so at a time. Great views. Probably closes at 4:00.
- Bunker Hill Museum - free to visit. Probably closes at 4:00.
- Consider the Freedom Trail. A walking audio tour - there is 90 minutes of listening explaining the Revolution. If we park near the USS Constitution, it is about a 4 KM walk to the start, but it finishes near the parking lot. It is on the NPS app.
- At the Harbour are three large animal sculptures.
