- **Trevi Fountain at Caesars Palace Las Vegas** - Photo op.
- **FIREWORKS!!!** - Launched from Caesars Palace at **9:00**. If our hotel faces it, maybe consider watching it from the room.
- **Vegas doesn't close** - Consider walking the Strip. It is 7 KM long (3 hours if we walk all of it.) Watch out for pickpockets!!!
- What cannot be done tonight, we can save for another night.

We will be using the public transit here. We will be riding The Deuce. A ticket booth is at the bus stop at Caesars Palace. It is 2 KM from the hotel (30 min walk). Buy a 24-hour pass. It runs every 10 to 20 minutes, 24 hours a day. BRING WATER. Expect summer heat when we walk from location to location. Lots of walking. Out for a long time.

- **Haus of Gaga** - Free. Opens at 12:00. Located at MGM. **Aria Fine Art Collection** is in this area too. 3KM/50 min. S: 45 L: 1:50
- **Real Bodies Las Vegas** - Tickets are in the email. Opens at 11:00. Located inside Horseshoe Las Vegas. 1.5 KM/25 min. S: 60 L: 3:20
- **NB Las Vegas at Harrahs** - Walk to this bus stop. If there is a closer one, take that one instead. Get off at **NB Las Vegas at Fontainebleau**. This is across from Circus Circus. 1.5 KM/20 min.
- **Circus Circus** - Find out when the circus (free shows) are on. There are other types of performances so plan on seeing as many as possible. Shows seem to be every hour. S: 90 L: 5:20

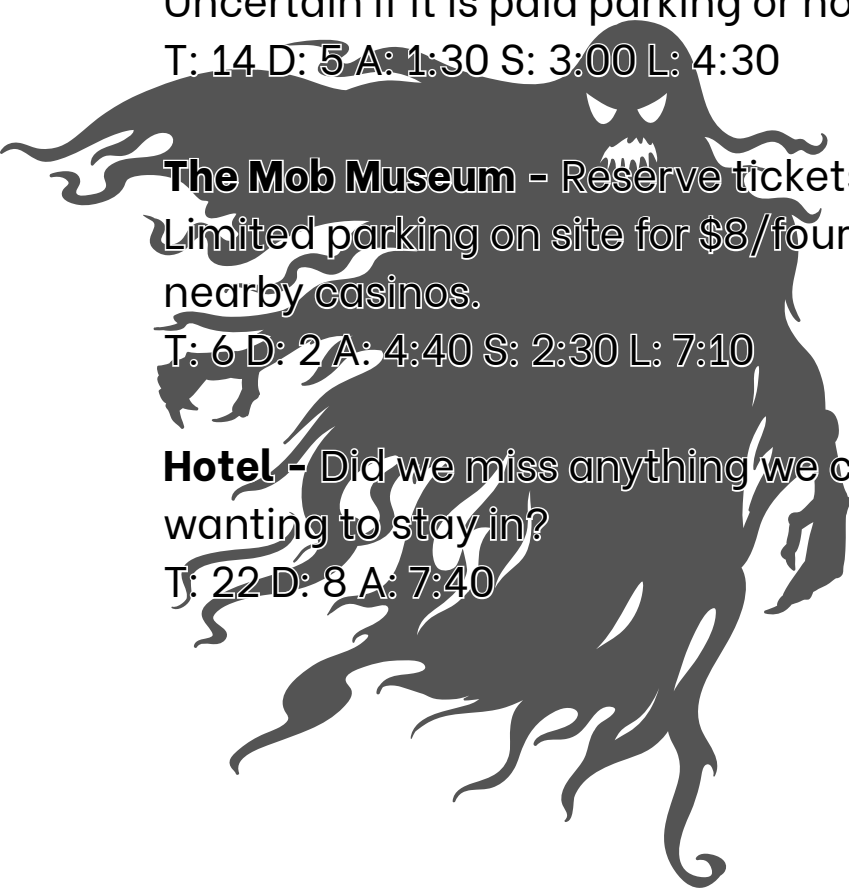

Thursday, July 9



Wake: 5:30 Breakfast and break camp **Leave:** 7:00

Drive to Visitor Center - Park here and take the shuttle.

- **Temple of Sinawava** - This is the last stop on the shuttle route. Take the Riverside Walk to the end. At this point, there are stairs down to Virgin River. The trail requires to walk in the river. Water levels fluctuate and the riverbed is uneven. Walk as much as we desire remembering we must head back the way we came. 90 minutes. Restroom. **Check weather for potential of rain - serious flash flood hazard.**
- **Weeping Rock** - Short but steep trail to see a wall of rock that is flowing. Flow rate will change depending on weather. 40 minutes. Pit toilet.
- **The Grotto** - A relatively flat location and best trail (for us) to see animals. It parallels the road and ends at Zion Lodge. Restroom. 40 minutes
- **Zion Human History Museum** - Check this place out if we had not the time when last night.
- Return to Visitor Center.

Leave Zion but take advantage of every viewpoint. At the very end of the tunnel, there is a very small parking lot (we will be lucky if we get a spot). Park there and cross the road for **Canyon Overlook**. It is a 2 KM roundtrip hike to an amazing view. It will be a hard hike.

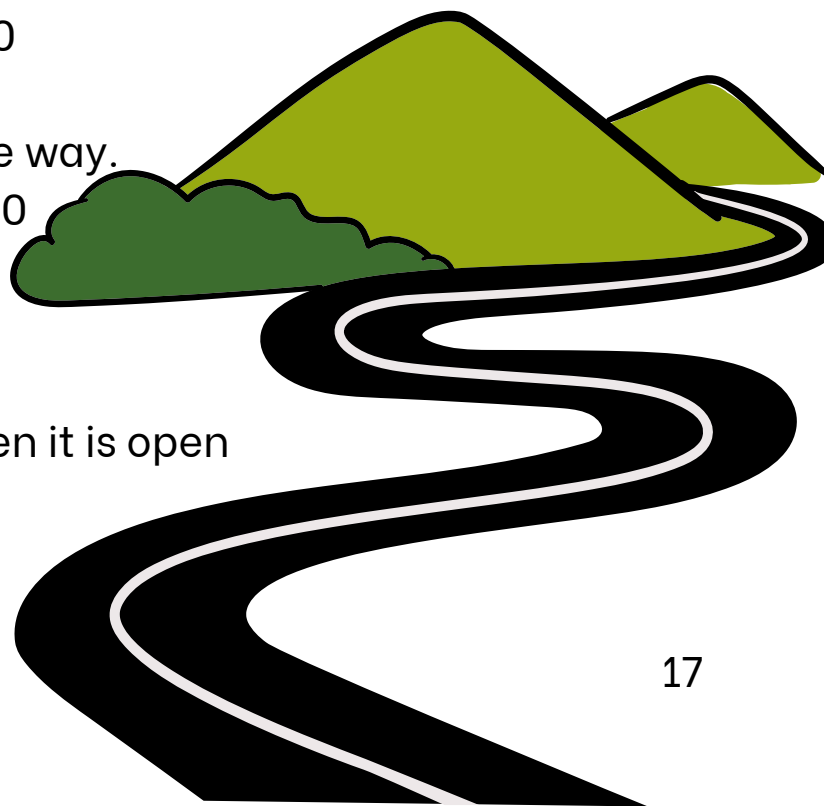

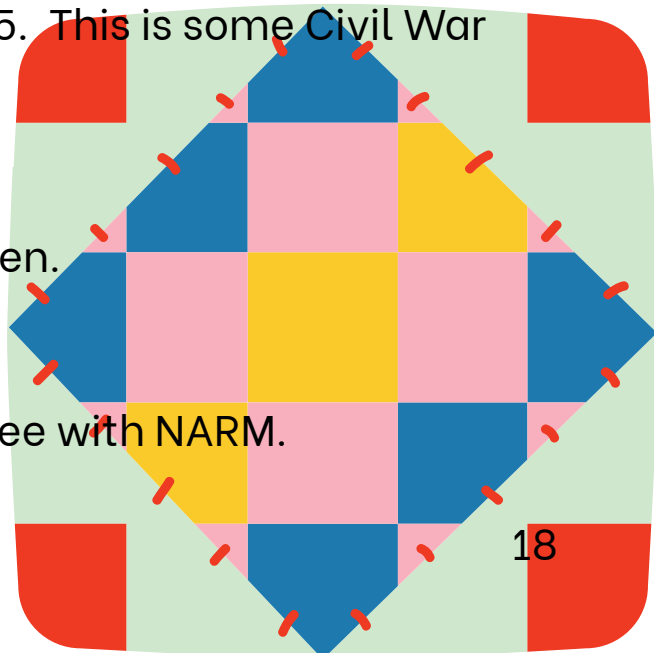
